Are you Ready?

Universal Credit is a new benefit for working aged people in and out of work, which will bring the following state benefits together into one monthly single payment:-

- Housing Benefit
- Employment Support allowance (Income Related) • Income Support
- Child Tax Credit

- Jobseekers Allowance (Income Based)
- Working Tax Credit

What will I have to do to get Universal Credit?

- DWP expect you to claim online, so you will need access to the internet to make a claim.
- You will need an email address.
- You will need to have a Bank Account/Building Society/Post Office account/Credit Union to get your Universal Credit payment.
